

European REACh Regulation No. 1907/2006 Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals

Aluminium alloys are defined in the REACh Regulation as 'special preparations', so the individual alloying substances must be taken into account.

In this context, the component substances of our alloys are fully eligible for exemption under Art. 2.7(d), as they fulfil the conditions set out in the Regulation for this purpose:

- the substances have already been registered by primary producers or importers in the European Community;
- the substances resulting from the production process are the same as those already registered;
- the pre-registration of the substances contained in the alloys we produce has been carried out;
- the information referred to in Articles 31 and 32 is available to the recoverer.

The metals that make up the alloy meet the characteristics and weight percentages specified in the UNI EN 573-3:2013 standard and none of the elements is, to date, included in Annex XIV (SVHC list) and in the Candidate

List (last update of 25.06.2025), in accordance with EC Regulation no. 1907/2006 (REACh) in concentrations higher in the Annex XIV (SVHC list) and Candidate List (25.06.2025), in accordance with the than 0.1% w/w.
